#### **Doctoral Consortium Call for Nominations**

The International Conference on Information Systems invites nominations for its 2014 Doctoral Consortium (DC), to be held Wednesday 10th December (evening) to the end of Friday 12th December 2014 (departure on Saturday 13th). Attendees are expected to attend for the full extent of the DC.

The consortium provides students who are doing their doctoral dissertations with the chance to present and obtain comments on their research, to hear about the work of their peers at other universities, and to gain an understanding of what academic and research careers are all about. It also offers students opportunities to make new friendships with other students and leading academics from around the globe.

Students nominated by their respective institutions must complete three separate documents and then submit them through the online submission system. # Consortium Eligibility

Participation in the consortium is by invitation only. Each university may submit only one nominee. If two units of a university hold separate memberships in AIS, they each may submit one nominee from their respective unit. Each student selected for the Consortium is expected to attend all Consortium meetings and activities, from the opening on Wednesday evening to the closing on Friday evening. Candidates who are not able to make this commitment to the Consortium should not apply.

Ph.D. students currently working on Information Systems dissertation are eligible for nomination. Candidates should have successfully defended their thesis proposals prior to December 1, 2014, although they need not have defended their proposals before the submission deadline. Students who will have defended their final dissertations prior to December 1, 2014 are not eligible.

### Consortium Venue

The event will be held at Castaways Resort (http://www.castaways.co.nz/), a coastal cliff top location, described as one of Auckland's most stunning conference venues, situated just 50 minutes from the centre of Auckland (location TBA).
